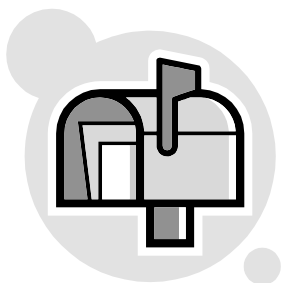

WHAT IS IT?

Books, Books-on-Tape or CD, music CDs, DVDs and videos are delivered by mail to patrons in Desoto, Tate, Panola, Lafayette, and Tunica Counties who cannot get to a library building because of illness, disability, or lack of transportation. Caregivers are also eligible.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Registered patrons of First Regional Library may request materials by title, subject, or type of material by calling 1-800-842-7820 ext. 125 and asking for Mrs. Lee Smith.

In addition to sending requested titles or books on a subject, someone will also select materials for you based on expressed reading preferences (mysteries, romance, westerns, nonfiction, etc.).

This service is free.

Instructions will be sent on how to return items in the mail free of charge. Patrons can also return materials to any branch of the First Regional Library.



HOW DO I REGISTER?

Call the First Regional Library at 1-800-842-7820 and ask for Books-by-Mail or Mrs. Lee Smith. If you already have a library card in good standing (no fines over \$3.00), you may provide information on reading preferences and begin using the system immediately. If you do not currently have a library card, you will be sent a Books-By-Mail application.

HOW MANY ITEMS CAN I CHECK OUT AT ONE TIME?

You may check out four films, but you may check out as many books as you wish. All materials are checked out for 30 days. You will receive overdue notices on anything not returned on time, but no fines will be charged. However, bills will be issued for lost materials.
