Use the same kit over and over for always-new discussion.

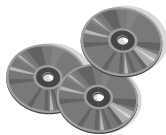


Just what exactly comes in the kit?



Audio-visual presentation

Manual

A how-to-do-it guide with instructions on how to get a program going, a list of questions that will stimulate discussion, resources and ideas for related activities.



Sing-Along

CD or cassette offers vocal and piano accompaniment for sing-along songs. You'll never be singing alone! Plus stories, mood music, or radio shows.

Booklets

Sing-along songs, poetry, photographs, and other discussion-starters are all printed in large type.



Skits or jokes

Add a touch of humor to a program. Offer another way to involve participants and prompt discussion.

Things to touch

Shapes and textures spark memories and encourage stories from older adults. (Some of these may be mystery items for younger people.)
